

# Deerlick Creek Park

Deerlick Creek Campground has 46 campsites. Sites 1-40 are equipped with water and electrical hookups, table, fire ring grills and lantern hangers. Sites 41-46 are primitive sites with water hook-ups only.

Campground amenities include hot showers, coin-operated laundry, flush toilets, a sanitary dump station, playground, fishing piers, hiking trails, paved biking trails, and picnic shelter. The Day Use Area features a boat ramp, toilets, playground, swimming beach, and ample parking.

Rules and Regulations have been designed for guest safety and enjoyment, as well as natural resource protection. A complete list of rules and regulations is posted on the bulletin board and available at the Park Attendant's Station. It is recommended that all park users become familiar with these regulations.

1. The campground gate will be locked from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. No visitors will be allowed during those hours. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. Unreasonably loud noise is prohibited anytime.
2. All facilities located within the Campground are for use by registered campers and paid visitors. All visitors who enter the campground must register at the Park Attendant's Station. Daytime visitors to the campground are limited to 6 per campsite. Camping fees cover a maximum of 8 people camping per site.
3. A boat ramp fee for non-registered campers will be charged per boat - per day. Annual Passes are available for purchase at any Corps of Engineers campground Park Attendant's Station or at the Project Office. The Annual Pass is accepted at any Corps of Engineers park that requires a use fee.
4. Campers are responsible for maintaining litter free sites. Trash must be placed in dumpsters or trash cans.
5. Camping is limited to 14 consecutive days in a 30 day period. Campsite must be occupied by person renting it.
6. Campsite occupancy is limited to one primary unit connecting to the power supply. Placing a tent outside designated campsite impact pad is prohibited. Vehicles and RV's must be parked on paved campsite areas. Vehicles are limited to 2 per campsite, and a fee for additional vehicles is required. Camping passes are to be hung from the rearview mirror or where it can be clearly seen. Only street legal vehicles are permitted in the park. Checkout time is 3:00 PM.
7. The discharge of gray water onto the ground or water is prohibited - a Sanitary Dump Station is provided.
8. No horses are allowed in the park. Other pets must be penned, or on a leash no longer than 6 feet.
9. Fireworks, firearms, explosives and projectile firing devices are prohibited.
10. Fires are to be confined to fireplaces, rings, or grills. All fires are to be fully extinguished upon departure.
11. Help protect our natural resources. Do not cut, damage, or hang items from trees. All vehicles and trailers must be parked in designated park spaces.
12. Day Use Park closes at sundown.
