



Bigbee Bottom Trail Map

Things to do:

Demopolis Site Office – Open M-F 8:00 to 4:30. The Demopolis Site Office houses our visitor's center information about area parks and history of the area.

Bigbee Bottom Nature Trail – This is a 2 mile loop trail that will one day be connected to the Lower Pool trail. It features bridges, wildlife viewing areas, and various reflection loops.

Lower Pool Park – This park gives a great view of the falls coming over Demopolis Dam. This is a primitive park with great views of the river and includes a boat launch area and a hiking trail.

Lower Pool Nature Trail – This is a 1 mile loop trail that takes you through dense hardwood areas. Along the way you will pass wildlife food plots for wildlife viewing.

Foscue Day Use Park – This park features a large playground, ballfield, and a boat launch (Free to campers). It also features the Foscue Creek Nature Trail which is a Tree Identification & Fitness Trail.

Foscue Campground – The Campground also features 2 playground areas along with its own short walking trail that leads to an observation tower overlooking the river.





Shelters - There are 3 shelters in the Foscue Day Use Park and 1 in the Foscue Campground. The Foscue Campground Shelter is for registered campers only. To reserve a shelter, contact the Foscue Campground Gatehouse or come by the Demopolis Site Office. A fee is charged for shelter use.
